Who decides the recipient of the scholarship?

A scholarship committee of the TCSC will review all completed scholarship applications. The committee reserves the right to rescind an award should a recipient's circumstances change, such as failure to graduate from high school or failure to enroll at an accredited institution. The Board of Directors of the TCSC will make the final decision on the recipients of this scholarship. The Board's decision shall be final. Preference may be given to students who are pursuing a degree related to the DNR, outdoors, wildlife biology, and conservation.
